Subject: Senate Bill No. 410

Summary

Senate Bill No. 410 designates a portion of U.S. Highway 69 in Bourbon and Crawford Counties as the Ken W Brock Memorial Highway.

Section 1 provides that the Ken W Brock Memorial Highway will begin on the portion of United States Highway 69 from the junction with grand road in Bourbon County, then south to the junction with East 650th Avenue in Crawford County. Highway signs designating the highway as the Ken W Brock Memorial Highway will not be placed until the requirements of K.S.A. 68-10,114 are met. K.S.A. 68-10,114 provides that the Secretary of Transportation should not place any signs designating memorial highways until receiving sufficient funds from gifts and donations to cover the costs of those signs. Additionally, the Secretary must receive an additional 50% of the initial cost to pay for future maintenance or replacement costs for the signs.
