Subject: Failure to Comply with Traffic Citation Offenses

Summary

Pursuant to K.S.A. 8-2110, failure to comply with a traffic citation means failure either to: (1) Appear before any district or municipal court in response to a traffic citation and pay in full any fine and court costs imposed; or (2) otherwise comply with a traffic citation as provided in K.S.A. 8-2118, and amendments thereto.

Under K.S.A. 8-2106, state infraction traffic citations may be issued for the following statutory offenses:
