A Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic (CCBHC) is a specially-designated clinic that provides a comprehensive range of mental health and substance use services.

What are CCBHCs Providing

CCBHCs represent an opportunity for states to improve the behavioral health of their citizens by:

- Providing community-based mental and substance use disorder services.
- Advancing integration of behavioral health with physical health care.
- Integrating and utilizing evidence-based practices on a more consistent basis.
- Promoting improved access to high quality care.

ALL who seek help!




Particularly valuable to individuals with:

Prospective Payment System

Prospective Payment System (PPS): Method of reimbursement in which Medicaid

payment is based on a predetermined, fixed amount.

Annual Allowable Costs

Annual Daily Visits

= PPS Rate

- State Needs Analysis (Mental Health Task Force)
- Need for Crisis Services
- Gaps in Continuity of Care
- EBP Fidelity & QA work
- Workforce Shortages
- Association of CMHCs of Kansas
- Lobbied for Kansas to move forward with CCBHC
- Sought CCBHC expansion grants from SAMHSA
- Legislative Mandate
- Required State to Transition to CCBHC Model by SFY25
- No Demonstration Status
- 9 CCBHCs to be certified by SFY23, 9 in SFY24, and 8 in SFY

- Onboard the last 6 CMHCs by July 1st, 2024.
- Applying to become a Demonstration State in March, 2024.
- Expanding capacity for technical assistance with centers.
- Developing policies and regulations for CCBHC.
- Rollout CCBHC Data Warehouse


