 - b. ongoing resources and training for technicians and supervisory staff
 - c. ability to hire higher education staff that are between technician and supervisory educational level
 - d. the efforts and work involved behind the scenes (i.e. case management/scheduling/follow up) that is not billable due to not being present with the client

 - a. Wait lists for the Autism Waiver and the I/DD Waiver (Intellectual /Developmental Disability)
 - b. Wait lists to have ABA across Kansas
- 5. Reimbursement Rates for ABA Codes How Kansas ranks compared to Midwest states:
- a. Kansas Medicaid pays 97153 \$11.75/unit (\$47.00/hour)
- b. Nebraska Medicaid 97153 pays \$35.06/unit (\$140.24/hour)
- c. lowa Medicaid 97153 pays \$16.34/unit (\$65.36/hour)
- d. Oklahoma Medicaid 97153 pays \$17.35 (\$69.40/hour)
- e. Missouri Medicaid 97153 pays \$16.12/unit (\$64.48/hour)
