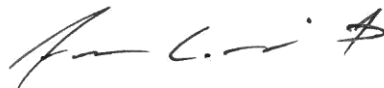
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2590 by House Committee on Energy, Utilities and Telecommunications

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2590 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2590 would amend current law to update the maximum civil penalties that may be imposed by the Kansas Corporation Commission (KCC) for pipeline safety violations to comply with requirements of the Federal Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration.

The KCC estimates that the enactment of the bill would not generate new revenue and would not have a fiscal effect. The KCC notes that the intention of the bill is to comply with the requirements of the Federal Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration.
