SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 486 by Senate Committee on Commerce

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 486 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Currently, the Department of Commerce charges an application fee up to \$750 for administering economic development incentive programs, including the Kansas Industrial Training and Retraining Program, the High Performance Incentive Program, the Promoting Employment Across Kansas Act, and the Job Creation Program. SB 486 would change the current application fee to between 0.5 percent and 2.0 percent of the total economic development program incentive package amount.

The Department of Commerce indicates SB 486 would generate additional revenues from the increase in fees; however, the agency is unable to estimate a fiscal effect because the fee would be a range based on the total incentive package. It is difficult for the agency to predict the number and size of projects that could be awarded in a year, which makes it impossible to project revenues from fees charged for the projects. Any fiscal effect associated with SB 486 is not reflected in *The FY 2025 Governor's Budget Report*.
