1 AN ACT concerning a vacancy in the office of governor; changing the 2 order of succession of such office; amending K.S.A. 75-125 and 3 repealing the existing section.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 75-125 is hereby amended to read as follows: 75-6 7 125. Whenever a vacancy shall occur in the office of governor, the 8 lieutenant governor shall become governor. Whenever the office of 9 lieutenant governor is vacant and a vacancy occurs in the office of governor, or whenever vacancies occur in the office of governor and 10 11 lieutenant governor at the same time, the president of the senate speaker of 12 the house of representatives shall become governor. Whenever the offices 13 of governor, lieutenant governor and president of the senate speaker of the 14 house of representatives are vacant, the speaker of the house of representatives president of the senate shall become governor. 15

16 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 75-125 is hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after itspublication in the statute book.
