22	accounts and reports is hereby authorized and directed to draw warrants on
23	the state treasurer in favor of the claimants specified in this act, upon
24	vouchers duly executed by the state agencies directed to pay the amounts
25	specified in such sections to the claimants or their legal representatives or
26	duly authorized agents, as provided by law.
27	(b) The director of accounts and reports shall secure prior to the
28	payment of any amount to any claimant, other than amounts authorized to
29	be paid pursuant to section 5 as motor-vehicle fuel tax refunds or as
30	transactions between state agencies as provided by this act, a written
31	release and satisfaction of all claims and rights against the state of Kansas
32	and any agencies, officers and employees of the state of Kansas regarding

33 their respective claims.

34 Sec. 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 35 publication in the Kansas register.
