## **HOUSE BILL No. 2647**

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AN ACT concerning rural communities in Kansas; creating the Kansas rural downtown revitalization act; establishing the rural downtown revitalization fund; making transfers to such fund; prescribing guidelines for the expenditure of moneys credited thereto and the duties of the department of commerce and the director of Kansas main street; requiring annual reports to certain committees of the legislature.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) Sections 1 through 5, and amendments thereto, shall be known and may be cited as the Kansas rural downtown revitalization act.

- (b) The purpose of the Kansas rural downtown revitalization act is to revitalize the downtown areas in rural Kansas towns and improve the quality of life in rural Kansas communities.
  - (c) As used in the Kansas rural downtown revitalization act:
- (1) "Director" means the director of Kansas main street in the department of commerce; and
- (2) "Eligible rural community" means a county with a population of 40,000 or less.
- Sec. 2. There is hereby established in the state treasury the rural downtown revitalization fund, which shall be administered by the department of commerce. All expenditures from the rural downtown revitalization fund shall be for grants to eligible rural communities. Each grant shall require a match of non-state moneys on a \$1-for-\$1 basis from private, local or federal resources. All expenditures from the rural downtown revitalization fund shall be made in accordance with appropriation acts upon warrants of the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the director of Kansas main street or the designee of the director.
- Sec. 3. (a) On July 1, 2024, July 1, 2025, July 1, 2026, July 1, 2027, July 1, 2028, and July 1, 2029, or as soon thereafter as moneys are available, the director of accounts and reports shall transfer \$2,000,000 from the state general fund to the rural downtown revitalization fund.
- (b) In each fiscal year in which moneys are authorized to be expended from the rural downtown revitalization fund of the department of commerce, the director shall award grants to eligible rural communities.

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(c) Any eligible rural community that desires to receive grant funds in any fiscal year shall develop and submit to the department of commerce a plan detailing the community's proposed use of grant and matching funds and any further requirements imposed by the director consistent with the purpose of this act. Plans shall be submitted at times and upon forms designated by the director.

- (d) The decision to award funds to any eligible rural community and the amount of any such award shall be within the director's discretion.
- Sec. 4. Beginning with the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025, in each fiscal year in which moneys are authorized to be expended from the rural downtown revitalization fund of the department of commerce, the director shall submit a report on the Kansas rural downtown revitalization act's effectiveness to revitalize the downtown areas in rural Kansas towns and improve the quality of life in rural Kansas communities. The report shall be submitted on or before the first day of the regular session of the legislature following the end of such fiscal year to the house of representatives committee on commerce, labor and economic development and the senate committee on commerce.
- 19 Sec. 5. The provisions of sections 1 through 4, and amendments 20 thereto, shall expire on July 1, 2030.
  - Sec. 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
