Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 2023 Supp. 75-774 is hereby amended to read as follows: 75-774. (a) In consultation with Native American Indian tribes, the Kansas bureau of investigation, the Kansas law enforcement training center and other appropriate state agencies, the attorney general may coordinate training regarding missing and murdered indigenous persons for law enforcement agencies throughout Kansas.

- (b) (1) Annually, on or before the third Monday of January, the attorney general shall submit to the house and senate standing committees on federal and state affairs a report on any coordinated training conducted pursuant to subsection (a).
- (2) Such report shall include the number of law enforcement agencies that participated, the number of agents who participated and the geographic jurisdiction of each such agent.
