Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 21-5407 is hereby amended to read as follows: 21-5407. (a) Assisting suicide is:

- (1) Knowingly, by force or duress, causing another person to commit or attempt to commit suicide; or
- (2) intentionally assisting another person to commit or to attempt to commit suicide by:
- (A) Providing the physical means *or knowledge about the physical means* by which another person commits or attempts to commit suicide; or
- (B) participating in a physical act by which another person commits or attempts to commit suicide;
- (3) communicating with another person with the intent to exercise substantial control over such person using such person's fears, affections or sympathies to cause such person to commit or attempt to commit suicide;
- 21 (4) knowingly exerting undue influence over another person with the 22 intent to cause such person to commit or attempt to commit suicide; or
 - (5) intentionally coercing or encouraging another person to commit or attempt to commit suicide.
 - (b) Assisting suicide as defined in:
 - (1) Subsection (a)(1) is a severity level 3, person felony; and
 - (2) subsection (a)(2) is a severity level 9, person felony;
- 28 (3) subsection (a)(3) is a severity level 5, person felony; and
 - (4) subsection (a)(4) or (a)(5) is a severity level 4, person felony.
- 30 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 21-5407 is hereby repealed.
- Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
