## HOUSE BILL No. 2793

> AN ACT concerning health and healthcare; relating to children and minors; prohibiting a healthcare provider from performing a healthcare service on a minor patient without parental consent; repealing K.S.A. $38-123$ and $65-2892 \mathrm{a}$.

## Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) As used in this section:
(1) "Appropriate licensing agency" means the agency that issues the license, certification or registration to the healthcare provider under this section.
(2) "Consent" means assent in fact, whether express or apparent.
(3) "Healthcare provider" means a person or entity defined as a healthcare provider under K.S.A. 65-4921, and amendments thereto, a person licensed by the board of nursing or a person licensed by the behavioral sciences regulatory board.
(4) "Healthcare service" means a service a healthcare provider that is authorized for performance on another individual under the scope of practice of such healthcare provider's license, certification or registration.
(5) "Minor" means an individual under 18 years of age.
(6) "Parent" means the same as defined in K.S.A. 38-141, and amendments thereto.
(b) (1) Except as provided in subsection (c), notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, a healthcare provider shall not perform a healthcare service on a minor without the consent of such minor's parent.
(2) A healthcare provider who violates the provision of paragraph (1) shall be subject to professional discipline from such healthcare provider's appropriate licensing agency.
(c) The provisions of this section shall not apply to K.S.A. 38-122, $38-123,38-137,38-2216,38-2217,65-2891,65-6704$, or 65-6705, and amendments thereto.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 38-123 and 65-2892a are hereby repealed.
Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
