AN ACT concerning motor vehicles; relating to license plates; requiring
certain license plates to have the county of registration for the motor
vehicle identified on the plate.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

6 Section 1. *(a)* On and after January 1, 2024, license plates furnished 7 for a motor vehicle and issued by the division of vehicles shall have 8 designated the county of registration for such motor vehicle. The director 9 of vehicles may either print the abbreviation of the county of registration 10 directly on the license plate or affix to the license plate by a decal the 11 abbreviation of the county of registration. *Except as otherwise provided in* 12 *subsection (b)*, The provisions of this section shall apply to:

(a)(1) Any passenger vehicle or truck as defined in K.S.A. 8-126, and
amendments thereto, that is subject to taxation pursuant to K.S.A. 79-5101
et seq., and amendments thereto; or

(b)(2) any vehicle that displays a distinctive or personalized license
plate.

18 (b) The provisions of this section shall not apply to distinctive 19 license plates designating a person as a recipient of the congressional 20 medal of honor issued pursuant to K.S.A. 8-1,145, and amendments 21 thereto.

22 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 23 publication in the statute book.
