AN ACT making and concerning appropriations for the fiscal years ending June 30, 2024, June 30, 2025, June 30, 2026, June 30, 2027, and June 30, 2028, for state agencies; authorizing certain transfers and increasing expenditure limitations to the foregoing; funding of the fiscal year 2024 salary increase for certain state employees; transferring funds from the legislature employment security fund of the legislative coordinating council to the university of Kansas and Wichita state university health collaboration fund of the university of Kansas, the Wichita state university and university of Kansas health collaboration fund of Wichita state university and the state general fund; authorizing certain expenditures from the build Kansas matching grant fund.

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Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1.

BOARD OF ACCOUNTANCY
