Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. Whenever a convention for proposing amendments to the constitution of the United States is called for by the states pursuant to article V of the constitution of the United States, the members of the senate then elected or appointed and qualified shall be the delegates designated to represent the state of Kansas at such convention. The secretary of state shall certify the identity of the delegates to the organizers of any such convention. In the event of a vacancy in a seat in the senate, no new delegate shall be designated as a representative of the state of Kansas until such time as such vacancy has been filled as provided by law, and upon being sworn into office, the senator filling such vacancy shall be designated as a delegate to such convention.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
