## **SENATE BILL No. 426**

AN ACT concerning traffic regulations; relating to unlawful passing of
 stationary authorized emergency vehicle; increasing penalties for
 certain violations; creating a crime for injuring or causing death of
 certain authorized emergency vehicle operators and providing a penalty
 therefor; amending K.S.A. 8-1530, 8-2116 and 8-2118 and repealing
 the existing sections.

8 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

9 Section 1. K.S.A. 8-1530 is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-10 1530. (a) Upon the immediate approach of an authorized emergency 11 vehicle making use of an audible signal meeting the requirements of 12 K.S.A. 8-1738(d), and amendments thereto, and visual signals meeting the 13 requirements of K.S.A. 8-1720, and amendments thereto, or of a police 14 vehicle properly and lawfully making use of an audible signal only, the driver of every other vehicle shall do the following unless otherwise 15 16 directed by a police officer:

(1) Yield the right-of-way;

(2) immediately drive to a position parallel to and as close as possibleto the right-hand edge or curb of the roadway clear of any intersection; and

(3) stop and remain in such position until the authorized emergencyvehicle has passed.

(b) The driver of a motor vehicle upon approaching a stationary
authorized emergency vehicle, when the authorized emergency vehicle is
making use of visual signals meeting the requirements of K.S.A. 8-1720 or
8-1722(d), and amendments thereto, shall do either of the following:

(1) If the driver of the motor vehicle is traveling on a highway that consists of at least two lanes that carry traffic in the same direction of travel as that of the driver's motor vehicle, the driver shall proceed with due caution and, if possible and with due regard to the road, weather and traffic conditions, shall change lanes into a lane that is not adjacent to that of the stationary authorized emergency vehicle; or

(2) if the driver is not traveling on a highway of a type described in paragraph (1), or if the driver is traveling on a highway of that type but it is not possible to change lanes or if to do so would be unsafe, the driver shall proceed with due caution, reduce the speed of the motor vehicle and maintain a safe speed for the road, weather and traffic conditions. 1 (c) This section shall not operate to relieve the driver of an authorized 2 emergency vehicle from the duty to drive with due regard for the safety of 3 all persons using the highway.

4 (d) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) or (3), a violation of 5 subsection (b) is a traffic infraction and shall be subject to a fine of \$400.

6 (2) Except as provided in paragraph (3), a violation of subsection (b) 7 that results in injury or great bodily harm to any person serving as a law 8 enforcement officer, an emergency medical service provider or a law 9 enforcement officer and such vehicle is an authorized emergency vehicle 10 that is a fire department vehicle, police bicycle, police vehicle or an 11 ambulance is a severity level 6, person felony.

(3) Violation of subsection (b) that results in death to any person
serving as a law enforcement officer, an emergency medical service
provider or a law enforcement officer and such vehicle is an authorized
emergency vehicle that is a fire department vehicle, police bicycle, police
vehicle or an ambulance is a severity level 4, person felony.

17 (4) In addition to the penalty described in paragraph (2), the court
18 shall impose a fine of not less than \$1,000.

19 (5) In addition to the penalty described in paragraph (3), the court 20 shall impose a fine of not less than \$7,500.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 8-2116 is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-2116. (a) Every person convicted of violating K.S.A. 8-1530(d)(1) and 8-2503, and amendments thereto, or violating any of the sections listed in the uniform fine schedule in K.S.A. 8-2118, and amendments thereto, is guilty of a traffic infraction.

(b) Except where another penalty or class of misdemeanor is 26 provided by statute, every person convicted of violating any provision of 27 the uniform act regulating traffic on highways designated as a 28 misdemeanor is guilty of a class C misdemeanor, except that upon a 29 second such offense committed within one year after the date of the first 30 31 such offense, upon conviction thereof, such person is guilty of a class B 32 misdemeanor, and upon a third or subsequent such offense committed 33 within one year after the first such offense, upon conviction thereof, such 34 person is guilty of a class A misdemeanor.

Sec. 3. K.S.A. 8-2118 is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-2118. (a) A person charged with a traffic infraction shall, except as provided in subsection (b), appear at the place and time specified in the notice to appear. If the person enters an appearance, waives right to trial, pleads guilty or no contest, the fine shall be no greater than that specified in the uniform fine schedule in subsection (c) and court costs shall be taxed as provided by law.

42 (b) Prior to the time specified in the notice to appear, a person 43 charged with a traffic infraction may enter a written appearance, waive

right to trial, plead guilty or no contest and pay the fine for the violation as 1 2 specified in the uniform fine schedule in subsection (c) and court costs 3 provided by law. Payment may be made in any manner accepted by the court. The traffic citation shall not have been complied with if the payment 4 is not honored for any reason, or if the fine and court costs are not paid in 5 6 full. When a person charged with a traffic infraction makes payment 7 without executing a written waiver of right to trial and plea of guilty or no 8 contest, the payment shall be deemed such an appearance, waiver of right 9 to trial and plea of no contest.

10 (c) The following uniform fine schedule shall apply uniformly 11 throughout the state but shall not limit the fine that may be imposed 12 following a court appearance, except an appearance made for the purpose 13 of pleading and payment as permitted by subsection (a). The description of 14 offense contained in the following uniform fine schedule is for reference 15 only and is not a legal definition.

(d) Traffic offenses classified as traffic infractions by this section shall be classified as ordinance traffic infractions by those cities adopting ordinances prohibiting the same offenses. A schedule of fines for all ordinance traffic infractions shall be established by the municipal judge in the manner prescribed by K.S.A. 12-4305, and amendments thereto. Such fines may vary from those contained in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection (c).

(e) Fines listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection
(c) shall be doubled if a person is convicted of a traffic infraction<del>, which</del> *that* is defined as a moving violation in accordance with rules and
regulations adopted pursuant to K.S.A. 8-249, and amendments thereto,
committed within any road construction zone as defined in K.S.A. 81458a, and amendments thereto.

34 (f) For a second violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and 35 amendments thereto, within two years after a prior conviction of K.S.A. 8-36 1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction shall be fined  $1^{1/2}$  times the applicable amount from one, but not both, of 37 the schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection 38 39 (c). For a third violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments 40 thereto, within two years, after two prior convictions of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 41 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction shall be 42 fined two times the applicable amount from one, but not both, of the 43 schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection (c).

1 For a fourth and each succeeding violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, 2 and amendments thereto, within two years after three prior convictions of 3 K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon 4 conviction shall be fined  $2^{1}/_{2}$  times the applicable amount from one, but 5 not both, of the schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in 6 subsection (c).

7 (g) Fines listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection 8 (c) relating to exceeding the maximum speed limit, shall be doubled if a 9 person is convicted of exceeding the maximum speed limit in a school 10 zone authorized under K.S.A. 8-1560(a)(4), and amendments thereto.

(h) For a second violation of K.S.A. 8-1556, and amendments thereto, 11 12 within five years after a prior conviction of K.S.A. 8-1556, and amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction, shall be fined \$750 for 13 14 the second violation. For a third and each succeeding violation of K.S.A. 8-1556, and amendments thereto, within five years after two prior 15 16 convictions of K.S.A. 8-1556, and amendments thereto, such person, upon 17 conviction, shall be fined \$1,000 for the third and each succeeding 18 violation.

Sec. 4. K.S.A. 8-1530, 8-2116 and 8-2118 are hereby repealed.

20 Sec. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 21 publication in the statute book.
