## SENATE BILL No. 437

AN ACT concerning education; establishing the Kansas education enrichment program; authorizing educational awards to certain elementary and secondary students for qualifying expenses for educational goods and services; requiring the state treasurer to administer the program; establishing the Kansas education enrichment program fund; making and concerning appropriations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025, for the department of revenue.

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WHEREAS, The Kansas education enrichment program has successfully provided direct assistance to families, contributing to their health and wellness; and

WHEREAS, The Kansas education enrichment program is designed for qualified students that will enroll in a public elementary or secondary school during the school year and will provide such students a grant of \$1,000 to pay for educational goods and services; and

WHEREAS, The success of our state depends on the success of Kansas families and every Kansas family could benefit from this program; and

WHEREAS, The legislature affirms the Kansas education enrichment program should continue.

Now, therefore:

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1.

## STATE TREASURER

- (a) There is appropriated for the above agency from the state general fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025, the following:
- 26 Kansas education enrichment program.....\$100,000,000
- 27 Provided, That expenditures shall be made by the above agency from the
- 28 Kansas education enrichment program account to provide grants to 29 families in amounts determined pursuant to section 2, and amendments
- 30 thereto.
  - Sec. 2. (a) This section shall be known and may be cited as the Kansas education enrichment program act.
    - (b) As used in the Kansas education enrichment program act:
  - (1) "Program" means the Kansas education enrichment program established in subsection (c).
    - (2) "Qualified student" means a resident of Kansas who is eligible to

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enroll in and attend kindergarten or any of the grades one through 12 at a public school in this state.

- (3) "Qualifying expenses" means expenses paid for educational goods and services, including, but not limited to:
  - (A) Tutoring;

- (B) extended school day educational programs;
- (C) academic and arts-related day or summer camps;
- (D) assessments;
- (E) uniforms for school-related activities;
- (F) educational, learning or study skills services; and
- (G) any other services offered by school districts or other education providers.
- (4) "Treasurer" means the state treasurer or the state treasurer's designee.
- (c) There is hereby established the Kansas education enrichment program to award grants to qualified students for qualifying expenses. The program shall be implemented and administered by the treasurer.
- (d) Each qualified student shall be eligible to receive two separate payments of \$1,000. The first payment shall be made when the qualified student is eligible to enroll in any of the grades one through eight. The second payment shall be made when the qualified student is eligible to enroll in any of the grades nine through 12. No qualified student shall receive more than one award in a school year and such award shall not be more than \$1,000. No qualified student shall receive more than \$2,000 in total awards from the program.
- (e) Awards may be administered and distributed by a third-party vendor. Such vendor shall create a digital account for each qualified student receiving an award under the program. Such digital account shall allow for reimbursement and direct payment for qualified expenses.
- (f) The treasurer shall determine annually the total amount to be transferred to the Kansas education enrichment program fund by multiplying the number of qualified students who will receive an award under the program by \$1,000 for the next succeeding school year. The treasurer shall certify the amount to the director of accounts and reports on or before August 1 of each year. On July 1, 2025, and each July 1 thereafter, or as soon after each such date as moneys are available, upon receipt of such certification, the director of accounts and reports shall transfer the amount certified from the state general fund to the Kansas education enrichment program fund.
- (g) There is hereby established in the state treasury the Kansas education enrichment program fund. Such fund shall be administered by the treasurer subject to the provisions of this section. All expenditures from the Kansas education enrichment program fund shall be for grants for

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qualified students for qualifying expenses as provided by this section. All expenditures from the Kansas education enrichment program fund shall be made in accordance with the provisions of appropriation acts upon warrants of the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the treasurer or the treasurer's designee. Moneys not expended in any fiscal year shall remain in the Kansas education enrichment program fund.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
