SESSION OF 2024

SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2703

As Recommended by House Committee on Education

Brief*

HB 2703 would add students in the custody of the Secretary for Children and Families (Secretary) to the list of students identified as eligible to receive at-risk programs and services.

Background

The bill was introduced by the House Committee on Education at the request of Representative Estes.

House Committee on Education

In the House Committee hearing, **proponent** testimony was provided by Representative Estes and a representative of the Kansas Association of School Boards. The conferees generally stated the bill would ensure students in the custody of the Secretary are eligible for at-risk services regardless of whether they qualify under other factors.

No other testimony was provided.
