- **9-2215.** Change in licensee's business; notice. (a) A licensee shall provide written notice to the commissioner within 10 business days of the occurrence of any of the following events:
- (1) The closing or relocation of the principal place of business or the addition or closing of any branch office;
- (2) a change in the licensee's name or legal entity status; or
- (3) the addition or loss of any loan originator, owner, officer, partner or director.
- (b) The commissioner may request additional information concerning any written notice received pursuant to subsection (a) and charge a reasonable fee for any action required by the commissioner as a result of such notice and additional information. **History:** L. 1999, ch. 45, § 14; L. 2001, ch. 88, § 15; L. 2022, ch. 30, § 7; July 1.
