

2023 Kansas Statutes

53-5a04. Authority to perform notarial acts. (a) A notarial officer may perform the following notarial acts:

- (1) Taking an acknowledgment;
 - (2) administering an oath or affirmation;
 - (3) taking a verification upon oath or affirmation;
 - (4) witnessing or attesting a signature;
 - (5) certifying or attesting a copy;
 - (6) noting a protest of a negotiable instrument; and
 - (7) performing a notarial act authorized by the law of this state.
- (b) A notarial officer may certify that a tangible copy of an electronic record is an accurate copy of the electronic record.
- (c) This section shall take effect on and after January 1, 2022.
