2023 Kansas Statutes

71-1304. Election for approval of consolidation. The territory of the consolidated
community college district shall be all of the territory of the community college
districts being consolidated. All of the electors residing in the community college
districts being consolidated shall be entitled to vote at such election. The proposition
submitted shall be stated on the ballot and in the notice of election in substantially
the following words: "Shall community college and community college
form a consolidated community college district?" and the blanks shall be filled with
the names of each of the community colleges being consolidated. The question shall
be followed by the words: "To vote in favor of the consolidation make a cross × mark
in the square after the word 'yes'. To vote against the consolidation make a cross \times
mark in the square after the word 'no'." The proposition shall be deemed approved if a
majority of those voting thereon in each community college district being
consolidated shall vote "yes." The county election officer of the county of the
community college having the greatest population shall conduct the election. Laws
applicable to question submitted elections in community college districts shall be
applicable in the conduct of the elections provided for under this section to the extent
that the same are not in conflict herewith.
