1 AN ACT concerning state government; relating to the transfer of all 2 powers, duties and functions of the adult protective services program of 3 the department of social and rehabilitation services to the office of the 4 attorney general of the state of Kansas. 5

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) All of the powers, duties and functions of the
department of social and rehabilitation services concerning adult
protective services are hereby transferred to and conferred and imposed
upon the office of the attorney general of the state of Kansas.

(b) The office of the attorney general of the state of Kansas shall be 11 12 the successor in every way to the powers, duties and functions of the 13 department of social and rehabilitation services concerning adult 14 protective services in which the same were vested prior to the effective 15 date of this section. Every act performed in exercise of such powers, duties 16 and functions by or under the authority of the office of the attorney general 17 of the state of Kansas shall be deemed to have the same force and effect as 18 if performed by the department of social and rehabilitation services, in 19 which such powers, duties and functions were vested prior to the effective 20 date of this section.

(c) All rules and regulations of the department of social and rehabilitation services concerning adult protective services in existence on the effective date of this section shall continue to be effective and shall be deemed to be duly adopted rules and regulations of the office of the attorney general of the state of Kansas until revised, amended, revoked or nullified pursuant to law.

(d) All orders and directives of the department of social and
rehabilitation services concerning adult protective services in existence on
the effective date of this section shall continue to be effective and shall be
deemed to be orders and directives of the office of the attorney general of
the state of Kansas until revised, amended or nullified pursuant to law.

(e) On the effective date of this section, the balances of all funds or accounts thereof appropriated or reappropriated for adult protective services of the department of social and rehabilitation services relating to the powers, duties and functions transferred by this section shall be transferred by the director of accounts and reports to the office of the 1 attorney general of the state of Kansas and shall be used only for the 2 purpose for which the appropriation was originally made.

3 (f) On the effective date of this section, all officers and employees 4 who, immediately prior to such date, were engaged in the performance of 5 powers, duties and functions of the department of social and rehabilitation 6 services concerning adult protective services which are transferred by this 7 section, or who became part of the office of the attorney general of the 8 state of Kansas, or the powers, duties and functions of which are 9 transferred to the office of the attorney general of the state of Kansas, and 10 who, in the opinion of the attorney general, are necessary to perform the powers, duties and functions of the office of the attorney general of the 11 12 state of Kansas, shall be transferred to, and shall become officers and 13 employees of the office of the attorney general of the state of Kansas. All 14 classified employees so transferred shall retain their status as classified 15 employees. Thereafter, the attorney general may convert vacant classified 16 positions to positions in the unclassified service under the Kansas civil 17 service act

18 (g) Officers and employees of the department of social and 19 rehabilitation services transferred by this section shall retain all retirement 20 benefits and leave balances and rights which had accrued or vested prior to 21 the date of transfer. The service of each such officer and employee so 22 transferred shall be deemed to have been continuous. All transfers, layoffs 23 or abolition of classified service positions under the Kansas civil service 24 act shall be made in accordance with the civil service laws and any rules 25 and regulations adopted thereunder. Nothing in this section shall affect the 26 classified status of any person employed by the department of social and 27 rehabilitation services prior to the date of transfer.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and afterJanuary 1, 2013, and its publication in the statute book.
