1 AN ACT making and concerning appropriations for the fiscal year ending
2 June 30, 2011, for state agencies; authorizing certain transfers,
3 imposing certain restrictions and limitations, and directing or
4 authorizing certain receipts, disbursements and acts incidental to the
5 foregoing.

6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

7 Section 1. (a) For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011,
8 appropriations are hereby made, restrictions and limitations are hereby
9 imposed, and transfers, capital improvement projects, fees, receipts,
0 disbursements and acts incidental to the foregoing are hereby directed or
1 authorized as provided in this act.

2 (b) The agencies named in this act are hereby authorized to
3 initiate and complete the capital improvement projects specified and
4 authorized by this act or for which appropriations are made by this act,
5 subject to the restrictions and limitations imposed by this act.

6 (c) This act shall not be subject to the provisions of subsection
7 (a) of K.S.A. 75-6702, and amendments thereto.

8 (d) The appropriations made by this act shall not be subject to
9 the provisions of K.S.A. 46-155, and amendments thereto.
