KSA 22-4519 et seq. created the nine-member State Board of Indigents' Defense Services appointed by the Governor, subject to confirmation by the Senate as provided in KSA 75-4315b. The Board is a part of the Executive Branch of state government.

Members serve for terms of three years and until their successors are appointed and confirmed.

The membership of the Board is as follows:

- Two members from the first congressional district, of whom one shall be a lawyer registered with the Kansas Supreme Court, and at least one member from each other congressional district in the state;
- At least one member from each county in the state having a population in excess of 100,000, who shall be a lawyer registered with the Kansas Supreme Court, but not more than five members from such counties; and
- Five members who are lawyers registered with the Kansas Supreme Court and four members who are not lawyers.

At any time, no more than five members of the Board may be from the same political party. The members of the Board cannot be employed by a judicial officer or a law enforcement officer. Also, no member of the Board is allowed to serve as an employee of the Board and serve more than two consecutive three-year terms.

State Board of Indigents' Defense Services

Powers and Duties

The Board has the power to:

- Provide, supervise, and coordinate, in the most efficient and economical manner possible, the constitutionally- and statutorily-required counsel and related services for each indigent person accused of a felony and for such other indigent persons as prescribed by statute;
- Establish, in each county or combination of counties designated by the Board, a system of appointed counsel, contractual arrangements for providing contract counsel, or public defender offices, or any combination thereof, on a full-time or part-time basis, for the delivery of legal services for indigent persons accused of felonies;
- Collect payments from indigent defendants as ordered by the court;
- Adopt rules and regulations which are necessary for the operation of the Board in the performance of its duties and for the guidance of appointed counsel, contract counsel, and public defenders. Such rules and regulations shall include:
 - Standards for entitlement to legal representation at public expense;
 - Standards and guidelines for compensation of appointed counsel and investigative, expert, and other services within the limits of appropriations;
 - Criteria for employing contract counsel; qualifications, standards, and guidelines for public defenders, appointed counsel, and contract counsel; and
 - Reimbursement tables which set forth the cost to the Board for each separate category of service provided;
- Prepare and submit to the Governor and Legislature an annual report on the operations of the Board.

In addition to the above powers and duties, the Board approved the development and implementation of the Appellate Defender Office as a statewide office to represent indigent felony defendants on appeal. The Board also created the Death Penalty Defense Unit to provide defense services to persons accused of murder when the potential penalty is death.
