Julian Efird, Kansas Legislative Research Department, gave a briefing on <u>House Sub for SB 259 – KPERS</u>, enacting the Kansas public employees retirement system act of 2014, prescribing employer and employee contributions and employee benefits and extending working after retirement provisions for certain school employees.
