## MINUTES OF THE SENATE ETHICS AND ELECTION COMMITTEE

The Chairman introduced a bill to transfer funds between candidacies. This bill passed the Senate last year, but did not pass the House.

Senator Brungardt moved, seconded by Senator Reitz. Motion carried.

Carol Williams, Executive Director, Governmental Ethics Commission, gave a short presentation on the Commission and requested two bills: disclosure of issue ads and filing fee increases that need to be raised as the fund for the Commission is being depleted.

Motion to introduce a bill to increase filing fees moved by Senator Apple, seconded by Senator Reitz. Motion carried.

The Chairman thanked Ms. Williams for appearing before the Committee.
