SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2119 by House Committee on Local Government

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2119 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Current law allows a township board or the governing body of a fire district to establish charges to individuals receiving rescue services inside or outside of the township or fire district. HB 2119 would prohibit a township or fire district from charging an "accident response service fee," which is defined in the bill.

The League of Kansas Municipalities indicates there would be no fiscal effect to Kansas cities. The Board of Emergency Medical Services states there would be no fiscal effect to agency operations resulting from the passage of HB 2119.
