
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2227 by House Committee on Corrections and Juvenile Justice

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2227 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Under current law, a warrant signed by a judge would contain the defendant's name and if the name is unknown then any name or description identifying the defendant could also be used. HB 2227 would also allow the defendant to be identified with a DNA profile.

HB 2227 would have no fiscal effect.
