**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2706 by House Committee on Government Efficiency

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2706 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2706 would reduce the number of appraisals required from three to one prior to the state's disposal or purchase of real property.

The Department of Administration indicates passage of HB 2706 would reduce costs spent to sell or purchase real property since the number of appraisals required would be reduced; however, the agency cannot provide a precise cost savings.
