1 AN ACT concerning the Kansas private and out-of-state post-secondary
2 educational institution act; relating to fees and the expiration thereof;
3 amending K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 74-32,181 and repealing the existing
4 section.

6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

7 Section 1. K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 74-32,181 is hereby amended to read as
8 follows: 74-32,181.

9 (a) The state board shall fix, charge and collect fees not to exceed the
10 following amounts by adopting rules and regulations for such purposes:

11 (1) For institutions domiciled or having their principal place of
12 business within the state of Kansas:

13 Initial application fees:

14 Non-degree granting institution.....\$2,000

15 Degree granting institution.....\$3,000

16 Initial evaluation fee (in addition to initial application fees):

17 Non-degree level.....\$750

18 Associate degree level.....\$1,000

19 Baccalaureate degree level.....\$2,000

20 Master's degree level.....\$3,000

21 Professional or doctoral degree level.....\$4,000

22 Renewal application fees:

23 Non-degree granting institution.....2% of gross tuition,

24 but not less than \$800, nor more than \$25,000

25 Degree granting institution 2% of gross tuition,

26 but not less than \$1,600, nor more than \$25,000

27 New program submission fees, for each new program:

28 Non-degree program.....\$250

29 Associate degree program.....\$500

30 Baccalaureate degree program.....\$750

31 Master's degree program.....\$1,000

32 Professional or doctoral degree program.....\$2,000

33 Program modification fee, for each program.....\$100

16 (b) Fees shall not be refundable.

17 (c) If there is a change in the ownership of an institution and, if at the
 18 same time, there also are changes in the institution's programs of
 19 instruction, location, entrance requirements or other changes, the
 20 institution shall be required to submit an application for an initial
 21 certificate of approval and shall pay all applicable fees associated with an
 22 initial application.

23 (d) An application for renewal shall be deemed late if the applicant
 24 fails to submit a completed application for renewal, or documentation
 25 requested by the state board to complete the renewal process, before the
 26 expiration date of the current certificate of approval.

27 (e) The state board shall determine on or before June 1 of each year
 28 the amount of revenue which will be required to properly carry out and
 29 enforce the provisions of the Kansas private and out-of-state
 30 postsecondary educational institution act for the next ensuing fiscal year
 31 and shall fix the fees authorized for such year at the sum deemed necessary
 32 for such purposes within the limits of this section. Prior to adoption of any
 33 such fees, the state board shall afford the advisory commission an
 34 opportunity to make recommendations on the proposed fees.

35 (f) Fees may be charged to conduct onsite reviews for degree granting
 36 and non-degree granting institutions or to review curriculum in content
 37 areas where the state board does not have expertise.

38 ~~(g) The provisions of this section shall expire on June 30, 2012.~~

39 **(g) The provisions of this section shall expire on June 30, 2017.**
