SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 275

As Recommended by Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs

Brief*

SB 275 would repeal KSA 41-333 to KSA 41-341, inclusive, that authorizes issuance of a salesperson's permit for the sale of, or the taking or soliciting of orders for the sale of alcoholic liquor or cereal malt beverages in the State of Kansas.

Background

According to a representative of the Kansas Department of Revenue, the application and issuance of salespersons' permits is burdensome to the industry and the Department, and serves no compelling state interest.

Written testimony in support of the bill was submitted by representatives of the Kansas Wine & Spirits Wholesalers Association and Kansas Beer Wholesalers Association.

No opponents testified on the bill.

According to the Kansas Division of the Budget, SB 275 would decrease revenue to the State General Fund by \$9,000 in FY 2013.
