

Dear Chairman Arlen Siegfreid and members of the House Federal and State Affairs Committee:

I write to you today in strong support of HB 2324, the Heartbeat Bill. This legislation indicates that children in the womb whose hearts are beating are to be protected. The heartbeat of the pre-born child begins to be detected at around 18-21 days after fertilization. This legislation, in other words, would protect the vast majority of children who now have no protection at all.

As I work nationally in the pro-life movement, I have seen support grow for this model of legislation.
