

PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL No. 2155

AN ACT concerning cosmetology; relating to licensure and renewal;
amending K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 65-1943, 65-1945 and 65-1950 and
repealing the existing sections.

Be amended:

On page 1, in line 35, by striking "apparently"; on page 2, in line 3, by striking the second comma which appears in the line

The change is shown in the bill language following:

(b) An applicant for apprentice licensure shall be required to pay a non-refundable fee established by rules and regulations adopted by the board and shall submit an application to the board showing to the satisfaction of the board that the applicant:

- (1) Is not less than 18 years of age;*
- (2) has a high school diploma or equivalent education; and*
- (3) will be studying under a trainer approved by the board.*

(c) Any applicant who [apparently] possesses the necessary qualifications to take an examination, as determined by the board, upon application and payment of a non-refundable fee established by rules and regulations adopted by the board, may be issued a temporary permit by the board to practice cosmetic tattooing, tattooing[;] or body piercing until the next regular examination conducted by the board.
