#### **Veterans Designation on Drivers Licenses or State ID Cards**

It can be difficult for military veterans to prove they served in the military. The only federally issued identification are: **Military ID cards**, military retiree ID cards, and **Veterans Identification Card** issued by the VA (only for eligible veterans). Veterans who are ineligible for one of these ID cards are often left without an official ID card that proves they served in the military.

Some veterans get around this by carrying around a copy of their **DD form 214**, but this presents a several issues: it is not a photo ID, so many places won't accept it, it is bulky and difficult to carry in one's wallet, and it has the veteran's Social Security number on it, which presents an identity theft risk if it is stolen.

More and more service members are returning home from overseas, and they need a more efficient way to prove eligibility for benefits that doesn't involve lugging around discharge papers,

An easy solution is to add the word "Veteran" or Combat Veteran" to the driver's license.

These driver licenses can often be used for **military and veterans discounts**, or to prove you served in the military. However, these ID cards are not official military ID cards.

Another important reason to include the veteran status is that veterans suffering from post-traumatic stress disorder (<u>PTSD</u>), have been known to scuffle with law enforcement after they return home. If police at the scene realize they're dealing with a veteran, one who may have <u>PTSD</u>, it could help them better handle the situation.

These state programs now make it easier for veterans to receive access to government benefits, discounts at restaurants and retailers, to which they are entitled.

### Requirements in most states:

#### For current service members and retirees:

- A current DD Form 2A
- Or surrender of a Driver's license from a state that already offers this service
- A DS 516 issued by the VA office

## For veterans that have previously served, but have not retired:

- An honorably or general under honorable conditions discharge
- A copy of your DD Form 214
- DD Form 215, or other discharge paperwork

### Additional state paperwork:

- · Birth certificate,
- Social security card,
- Passport or some other form of identification).

#### Process:

When you go to get your driver's license, the clerk will ask you if you are veteran and if you would like a veteran designation, on a voluntary (as desired by those Service Members/Retirees/Veterans), basis.

Those Veterans desiring to be so identified would be required to produce proof at the time of issuance, or renewal of their Driver's License
