
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2727 by House Committee on Transportation

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2727 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2727 would provide that placards and individual identification cards for persons with a disability must remain valid as long as the person or a person responsible for the transportation of a person with a disability is eligible for a special license plate or permanent placard. The bill would require the Secretary of Revenue to promulgate the rules and regulations necessary to remain compliant with federal law.

The Department of Revenue indicates that the enactment of HB 2727 would have a negligible fiscal effect on the State Highway Fund.
