1 AN ACT concerning utilities; relating to net metering; excess energy  
2 generated by customer-generator; amending K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 66-  
3 1266 and repealing the existing section.

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 66-1266 is hereby amended to read as  
7 follows: 66-1266. (a) If the electricity supplied by the utility exceeds the  
8 electricity generated by the customer-generator during a billing period, the  
9 customer-generator shall be billed for the net electricity supplied by the  
10 utility in accordance with normal practices for customers in the same rate  
11 class.

12 (b) If a customer-generator generates electricity in excess of the  
13 customer-generator's monthly consumption, all such net excess energy  
14 (NEG), expressed in kilowatt-hours, shall be carried forward from month-  
15 to-month and credited at a ratio of one-to-one against the customer-  
16 generator's energy consumption, expressed in kilowatt-hours, in  
17 subsequent months.

18 (c) Any net excess generation credit remaining in a net-metering  
19 customer's account ~~at the end of each calendar year~~ shall expire *after not*  
20 *more than 12 months on March 31, September 30 or December 31, as*  
21 *chosen by such customer. A customer may elect to change the expiration*  
22 *date of such customer's net excess generation credit by notifying the utility*  
23 *in writing at least 60 days prior to such customer's current expiration*  
24 *date.*

25 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 66-1266 is hereby repealed.

26 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
27 publication in the statute book.
