Chairman Powell recommended that **HB 2490** be amended to include the following changes:

- 1. Add in a provision of **HB 2164** to increase the substantial interest threshold from \$2000 to \$5000 and then up to \$15,000.
- 2. In HB 2180 exempt professional publications from being defined as a gift.
- 3. The new pay commission's recommendations would be binding only for legislators and not the executive branch. The revisors indicate that it is unconstitutional for the executive branch to be included.
- 4. Technical clean-up language to the bill. (attachment #1)

Representative Hermes moved that **HB 2490** be amended to include the above provisions. The motion was seconded by Representative Alldritt. The motion was passed.

Representative Alldritt moved and it was seconded by Representative Mayans that **HB 2490** as amended be favorably passed from the committee. The motion passed.
