The Chairperson stated that <u>HB 2666 - Child autopsies, court orders, elimination of</u> <u>unfunded liability for</u> had been passed out of committee and after looking at it further, decided to have it blessed and kicked back into committee and could discuss adding funding to the bill so counties could be held harmless and a loss of revenue not involved. Don Hermes sent each member information that \$1.00 added on to each death certificate would create enough money.
