The minutes of the meeting held on January 29, 2002 were approved.

The committee meeting scheduled for Thursday, January 31, 2002 was cancelled due to severe weather conditions.

The Chairman recommended the committee sponsor legislation conceptually to amend K.S.A. 2001 Supp. 72-6407, which relates to new school facilities weighting for financing. He explained that currently school districts with 25% L.O.B.'s may access weighting for new classrooms. The linkage to L.O.B. usage is no longer valid because changes in the law have eroded original arguments and has resulted in the unintended consequence of encouraging boards of education to increase local property taxes to secure needed funding. He so moved.. Representative Bethel seconded the motion; and the motion carried.
