## HB 2661 - Retail electric suppliers; service rights in area annexed by city; procedures; compensation when service rights terminated

Chairman Holmes opened the debate on <u>HB 2661</u>. <u>Representative Krehbiel moved to report HB 2661</u> favorably for passage. Representative Kuether seconded the motion. Motion carried. Representative Krehbiel will carry the bill.

## HB 2644 - Automatic pass through to customers of certain electric and natural gas utility costs for security measures

Chairman Holmes stated that the committee would have an informal discussion, without debate, on the bill. A proposed substitute (Attachment 1) was distributed and discussed. Paula Lentz, Assistant General Counsel for the Kansas Corporation Commission, provided detail on the proposed substitute as approved by the Commission. ## HB 2754 - Telecommunications; affordable rates; quality of service; standards
