HB 2999 - Public utilities, excluding certain landlords from definition

Chairman Holmes opened the debate on <u>HB 2999</u>. Karl Mueldener, Bureau of Water Director for Kansas Department of Health & Environment, addressed the previous days concern on K.S.A. 65-162a to the satisfaction of the committee. Anne Tymeson, Assistant General Counsel for the Kansas Corporation Commission, provided language regarding the Commission jurisdiction (Attachment 1).
