## SB 546 - Natural gas supplier, termination of franchises

Chairman Holmes opened the debate on <u>SB 546</u>. <u>Representative Dillmore moved to report SB 546 favorably for passage.</u> <u>Representative Lightner seconded the motion.</u> <u>Motion carried</u>. Representative Toelkes will carry the bill.

## SB 545 - Public utilities, public right-of-way, fees

A proposed substitute for SB 545 was distributed (Attachment 2). Representative Sloan moved to adopt the substitute. Representative Kuether seconded the motion. The motion carried.
