## SB 614 - Kansas Universal Service Fund funding for KAN-ED

Chairman Holmes opened the hearing on **SB 614**.

Mark Tallman, Assistant Executive Director for the Kansas Association of School Boards, spoke to the committee in support of **SB 614** (Attachment 1). Mr. Tallman stated that funding for the KAN-ED program was needed and this appeared to be a viable source. Mr. Tallman responded to questions from the committee.
