Chairman Corbin announced that the purpose of the meeting was to act on a resolution discussed at the April 30 meeting of the Committee, <u>HCR 5032</u>, which approves the creation of the City of Pittsburg Port Authority. He also announced that there would be no hearing on the companion bill, <u>HB 2586</u>, which would provide an income tax credit for payments to port authorities. He noted that <u>HCR 5032</u> is needed by Watco Companies in order to continue with efforts to ensure that rail lines are preserved. He offered committee members copies of a memorandum from Governor Graves in which the Governor expresses his support of both <u>HCR 5032</u> and <u>HB 2586</u>. (Attachment 1)
