Senator Corbin called the Committee's attention to <u>HB 3032</u>, which was heard and discussed by the Committee on May 2, 2002. ## HB 3023-Property taxation; determination of fair market value

Senator Corbin reminded the Committee that the provisions of <u>HB 3023</u> passed the Senate twice—in <u>SB 92</u> during the 2001 Session and in <u>HB 2795</u> during the 2002 Session. He noted that the bill deals with property tax from appraisers and that it passed the House.

Senator Jenkins moved to recommend **HB 3023** favorably for passage, seconded by Senator Lee. The motion carried.
