Moved by Senator Emler, seconded by Senator Lee, to approve the amendment to **HB 2746** adding the following language to Section 1 (i)... utility "or a generating plant specified in subsection (e) of K.S.A. 66-104, and amendments thereto, ".... and placed in use on or after January 1, 2002. Motion carried.

Moved by Senator Lee, seconded by Senator Brownlee, **H.B 2746** be passed out favorably as amended. Motion carried.

Chair continued the hearing on

<u>Sub for HB 2644</u> - Automatic pass through to customers of certain electric and natural gas utility costs for security measures.

Conferees who had formerly presented testimony were given an opportunity to comment. Some discussion on the original bill **HB 2644** (Attachment 2). After considerable discussion, the committee decided not to take action on the **Sub for HB 2644**.

Discussion was held on:

HB 2999 - Public utilities, excluding certain landlords from definition.

After discussion on HB 2999, the committee decided not to take action on HB 2999.
