HB 2623 -Designating part of K-20 highway as the Kickapoo veterans memorial highway

The Chairman opened the hearing on <u>HB 2623</u> by introducing Representative Larkin who introduced Emily Conklin, Vice Chair of the Kickapoo Tribe. (Attachment 1) According to Ms. Conklin she and several other members of the tribe were there in support of <u>HB 2623</u> designating a portion of K-20 between Highway 75 and Horton, KS as the Kickapoo Veteran's Memorial Highway. She said since March of 2000, the Kickapoo Tribe in Kansas has been a responsible partner with the State by participating in the Keep Kansas Clean by bi-annually cleaning K-20 Highway which services and runs through the heart of their reservation as well the Tribe has taken it upon itself to so honor the veterans by erecting a memorial which is located at the Kickapoo Pow-Wow Park parallel and visible to K-20 highway.

There were no other proponents and no opponents.

Chairman Hayzlett closed the hearing on HB 2623.

It was the Chairman's desire to work <u>HB 2623.</u> Representative Larkin made a motion to pass this bill out of Committee favorably, the motion was seconded by Representative Henry and the motion carried.
