

MINUTES OF THE HOUSE TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Gary Hayzlett at 1:30 p.m. on March 23, 2004 in Room 519-S of the Capitol.

Chairman Hayzlett opened the meeting. He called for final action on **SB 329**. Bruce Kinzie explained a technical amendment that needed to be made on page 2, line 19 of the bill indicating it only applies to paragraph 1 or 2. Representative Jack made a motion to include the technical amendment as explained by Bruce. The Motion was seconded by Representative Dreher and the motion to amend carried. Representative Vickrey made a motion to favorably pass **SB 329, as amended**. Representative Jack seconded the motion and the motion carried.

The Chairman called for final action on **SB 385**. Representative Yonally made a motion to table **SB 385**, seconded by Representative Myers. A division was called. There were 11 ayes and 5 nays. The motion to table carried. Representative Vickrey asked to be recorded as not wanting **SB 385** tabled.

Chairman Hayzlett called for final action on **SB 501**. Representative Davis handed out a proposed amendment (Attachment 1) and explained it to the Committee. The two changes involved workers compensation and the minimum for liability coverage per van. Representative Humerickhouse made a motion to accept this amendment, seconded by Representative Burgess, the motion to amend carried. Representative Davis made a motion to favorably pass **SB 501, as amended**. The motion was seconded by Representative Burgess and the motion carried.

Chairman Hayzlett called for final action on **Sub.SB 500**. Representative Wilk offered a balloon amendment (Attachment 2) and explained it to the Committee. Representative Wilk made a motion to accept the amendments, seconded by Representative Humerickhouse and the motion carried. Representative Humerickhouse made a motion for an additional amendment to include the language from HB 2860. The motion was seconded by Representative Vickrey and the motion carried. Representative Wilk made a motion to favorably pass **Sub. SB 500, as amended**, seconded by Representative Beggs and the motion carried.

The Chairman thanked the Committee and the staff for their diligent work throughout the session.

Chairman Hayzlett adjourned the meeting. There will be no additional Committee Meetings this session.
