Revisor Mitch Rice explained the substitute for SB 153 regarding Enhanced 911. Every wireless subscriber will be required to pay an additional 75 cents per month. The issue of equity was discussed, as wire customers have been subsidizing wireless 911 service. <u>Senator Barone moved to amend Sub SB 153</u> on page 7 to add "necessary and reasonable" in front of "costs" in section b. Senator Steineger seconded. <u>The motion carried</u>.

Concern was expressed that the committee does not know what the wireless carriers will do with the money. <u>Senator Bunten moved to amend the bill so that the audit will be done after 2 years, instead of 3.</u> <u>Senator Jordan seconded. The motion carried.</u>

Senator Jordan moved to pass the bill out of committee favorably for passage as amended. Senator Kerr seconded. The motion carried.
