Jeff Bottenberg, State Farm Insurance Company presented information (<u>Attachment 1</u>) requesting bill introduction that would allow insurers to issue contracts of insurance and other materials in a foreign language.

(Attachment 2) He also addressed some of the legislative issues that would come before the Committee, specifically, "payday loans." The Commission has a concern regarding the exorbitant interest rates and schemes that are in place to attract consumers.
